


2023 IMPACT REPORT



Our Accomplishments Supporting Member Libraries in 2023

Westmoreland Library Network kicked off 2023 by completing a strategic plan to re-evaluate operations and responsibly focus efforts for the benefit of all county residents. This plan resulted in eleven goals ranging from administration to services and programs, which will guide efforts over the next three years.

Staff members throughout the county noticed the library atmosphere felt "normal" for the first time since the pandemic. Patrons embodied the sense of community libraries strive to supply by visiting more consistently, utilizing resources, attending programs, and interacting with each other, staff, and volunteers.

Community extended beyond the individual buildings. Members Westmoreland Library Network are constantly engaged in collaborations, such as the Annual Countywide Chess Tournament held everv spring. Competitors earn their spot by finishing in the top 3 of their age group at their local library's qualifier. 2023 saw 46 challengers at the final tournament hosted by Greensburg Hempfield Area Library.

The Library Passport program is another countywide initiative that encouraged patrons to explore the entire county through an inaugural 14 libraries. Passports were taken to a host location to be stamped. While

there, they could complete an activity and browse local information. At the end of summer, participants were entered into a drawing for a prize basket. Visiting unfamiliar libraries raised awareness to the diverse communities and resources within our county.

Countywide initiatives like the Passport program radiated library walls. Westmoreland Library Network brought attention to other community assets like parks and local **Partnerships** included resources. organizations such as Westmoreland County **Parks** and Recreation, Westmoreland Land Trust, Westmoreland County Commissioners, and the Office of Commonwealth Libraries.

Westmoreland Library Network uses partnerships and engaged neighbors to information needs establish and opportunities. One response to these conversations Family History was Month being celebrated in October with a Genealogy Series for the first time. Four libraries across the county hosted expert speakers presenting varying levels of research and interest to ensure there was something for everyone.

Westmoreland Library Network is committed to providing quality services for every person in our county. We look forward to growing more in 2024.




